

Rules for PA Field (Grade 4/5)



1. Match Format will be 7v7, so 6 players and 1 goalie.
2. All games are two 15 minute halves, with a two minute half time. Game times may be adjusted by referees. There will be no time to warm up on the field. You have three minutes to cheer, shake hands and clear the field.
3. Please make sure that players use their own water bottles. Do not encourage sharing of this item.
4. Shin guards are mandatory.
5. No offsides
6. Unlimited substitutions.
7. Round Robin games end in a tie. Play- off games on this field will go to a five minute sudden death game. This will be immediately followed by a shoot- out. Please pick your kickers quickly. If after five kickers for each team, the score remains tied, sudden death penalty kicks will commence with different shooters.
8. Please keep the field clean and use the garbage cans provided.
9. _____ is the tournament whip for this field. The head referee will make interpretations on rules, as well.
10. Rayna Hayes is the statistician and will be collecting results in the library area at DJSS. If coaches have questions about standings, they need to see Jacquie.
11. **Respect is of the utmost importance.** NWT Soccer Association continues to provide referees. Also respect tournament organizers and scorekeepers. Their job is to help games progress smoothly.
12. If there is a tie-breaking situation after the round robin is complete. The tiebreakers are as follows:
 - Head-to-head result > GA > GF > Shoot-out between teams

Players will be recognized as the player of the game. Players will receive various prizes including the game ball, pins or stickers. These players will be selected by the referee.
